NOTE : *This is not a complete!* Also try ABC, music stores for Multicultural CD / Audio cassettes). Markets, Opportunity shops, Trash and Treasure, Ethnic supermarkets, delicatessens, Book stores, Weekend markets, Garage sales, Vietnamese shops along Hanson Road (Woodville Gardens), *Cheap as Chips, Spend a Penny, Spotlight, Bargain Busters, Dollar Shops*, and *Cunningham's* warehouses are all possibilities. The main way of locating resources is to actually look, search and ask people from specific ethnic backgrounds. *K-Mart, Target, Coles, Woolworths, Gouger Rugs* and *Homeart* (formerly *Copperart*) often have surprising finds that are relatively cheap to buy. Don't forget the *Adelaide Central Market* and surrounding shops (Gouger and Grote Streets), *Brick Works Market* (Thebarton), *Port Docks Market* (Port Adelaide) specialize in the alternative. Try also *Craft Fairs, Wooden toys* specialists, *Travel agencies* (posters), *Basket and cane ware*, Favourite (secondhand and alternative) *clothing* shops (*silks, Indian, Asian*), *Fabrics* outlets. Look for items such as: loose book jackets, food packages, cards/postcards, costume, hats, shoes, bags, jewellery, mobiles, cushion covers, textures, textiles, wall hangings, models, musical instruments, cultural items, hand made creations, bric-a-brac, decorations, lanterns, household items, carriers, photographs, printed materials in other languages (papers/magazines), stamps, coins, umbrellas (parasols), flowers and bright colours) Create a multicultural world!
